Submission Guidelines DEADLINE: April 1, 2024

Entries: Students may select one (1) piece of music to submit for this showcase.

Students should submit their music piece in MP3 format by uploading the file to the application below.

Only audio submissions will be accepted; no videos. Submissions cannot exceed 4 minutes. All musical pieces must be submitted by April 1, 2024

Judges will evaluate submissions based on theme interpretation and creativity. The piece must be original.

Only solo performances are permitted.

Each participating student musician must be between 13 and 18 by April 1, 2023. All entries must be the work of the entrant. Only pieces inspired by the theme should be submitted.

Music must be submitted to Franklin Sister Cities by Thursday, April 1, 2024. Students should submit their music pieces in MP3 or WAV format. Using file-sharing software such as Google Drive is likely necessary to send large files.

## Judging:

A panel will judge entries based on originality, composition, and theme interpretation. The musician's name, title, description of work, and school name are kept confidential until judging has been completed. The judges' decision will be final. The top five selected will be sent to Sister Cities International for the international competition.

<u>Local Competition:</u> First, Second, and Third place winners will be selected and awarded prizes by Franklin Sister Cities. First place will receive \$100, 2nd Place will receive \$75, and 3rd Place will receive \$50.

International Competition: First, Second, and Third place winners will be selected in the Sister Cities International competition. The Grand Prize Winner (first place) will receive \$1,000, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place will receive \$250, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place will receive \$100. The winners will be published on the Sister Cities International website.
